



Confession and Absolution


L: The Grace of our Lord † Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.



- **L:** On the day Jesus was crucified, ³⁵ The people stood watching, and the rulers even sneered at him. They said,
- C: "He saved others; let him save himself if he is the Christ of God, the Chosen One."
- **L:** ³⁶ The soldiers also came up and mocked him. They offered him wine vinegar and said,
- C: ³⁷ "If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself."
- **L:** ³⁸ There was a written notice above him, which read: THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS. ³⁹ One of the criminals who hung there hurled insults at him:
- C: "Aren't you the Christ? Save yourself and us!"
- **L:** ⁴⁰ But the other criminal rebuked him. "Don't you fear God," he said, "since you are under the same sentence? ⁴¹ We are punished justly, for we are getting what our deeds deserve. But this man has done nothing wrong." ⁴² Then he said to Jesus,
- C: "Remember me when you come into your kingdom."
- **L:** ⁴³ Jesus answered him, "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise." This is the Gospel of our Lord!
