

Glory be to the Father and to the Son* and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning,* is now, and will be forever. Amen.


Refrain

Romans 8:35-39

³⁵ Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? ³⁶ As it is written: "For your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered." ³⁷ No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

³⁸ For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, ³⁹neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Word of the Lord)

- L: ¹³ When Jesus heard that John was dead, he withdrew by boat privately to a solitary place. Hearing of this, the crowds followed him on foot from the towns. ¹⁴ When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and healed their sick. ¹⁵As evening approached, the disciples came to him and said,
- C: "This is a remote place, and it's already getting late. Send the crowds away, so they can go to the villages and buy themselves some food."
- L: ¹⁶ Jesus replied, "They do not need to go away. You give them something to eat."

C: ¹⁷ "We have here only five loaves of bread and two fish,"


L: ¹⁸ "Bring them here to me," Jesus said. ¹⁹ And he directed the people to sit down on the grass.
