

C: I meditate on it all day long.


L: Your commands make me wiser than all my enemies,


Prayer of the Church:

First Lesson: Jeremiah 17:5–8 (NIV 84)

⁵ This is what the LORD says: "Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who depends on flesh for his strength and whose heart turns away from the LORD. ⁶ He will be like a bush in the wastelands; he will not see prosperity when it comes. He will dwell in the parched places of the desert, in a salt land where no one lives. ⁷ "But blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in him. ⁸ He will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit." This is the Word of our God.





Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the <u>wicked*</u> or stand in the way of sinners.

But his delight is in the law of the LORD,* and on his law he meditates day and night.

He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in <u>season*</u> and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.

Therefore the wicked will not stand in the <u>judg</u>ment,* nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.

For the LORD watches over the way of the <u>right</u>eous,* but the way of the wicked will <u>per</u>ish.

Glory be to the Father and <u>to</u> the Son* and to the Holy <u>Spir</u>it, as it was in the beg<u>in</u>ning,* is now, and will be forever. <u>A</u>men.

Refrain

- ¹² But if it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?
- ¹³ If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. ¹⁴ And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith.
- ¹⁵ More than that, we are then found to be false witnesses about God, for we have testified about God that he raised Christ from the dead. But he did not raise him if in fact the dead are not raised.
- ¹⁶ For if the dead are not raised, then Christ has not been raised either.
- ¹⁷ And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins. ¹⁸ Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ are lost.
- ¹⁹ If only for this life we have hope in Christ, we are to be pitied more than all men.
- ²⁰ But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. This is the Word of the Lord.



Gospel:


Luke 6 17–26 (NIV 84)

- **L:** ¹⁷ Jesus went down with them and stood on a level place. A large crowd of his disciples was there and a great number of people from all over Judea, from Jerusalem, and from the coast of Tyre and Sidon, ¹⁸ who had come to hear him and to be healed of their diseases. Those troubled by evil spirits were cured, ¹⁹ and the people all tried to touch him, because power was coming from him and healing them all.
 - ²⁰ Looking at his disciples, he said: "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.
 - ²¹ Blessed are you who hunger now, for you will be satisfied. Blessed are you who weep now, for you will laugh.
 - ²² Blessed are you when men hate you, when they exclude you and insult you and reject your name as evil, because of the Son of Man.
 - ²³ "Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, because great is your reward in heaven. For that is how their fathers treated the prophets.
 - ²⁴ "But woe to you who are rich, for you have already received your comfort.
 - ²⁵ Woe to you who are well fed now, for you will go hungry. Woe to you who laugh now, for you will mourn and weep.
 - ²⁶ Woe to you when all men speak well of you, for that is how their fathers treated the false prophets.
