


C: Dearest Lord, I offer you praise and give you thanks. Alleluia! Alleluia!

Passion History:

Luke 22:66–23:12 (NIV 84)

- **L:** ⁶⁶ At daybreak the council of the elders of the people, both the chief priests and teachers of the law, met together, and Jesus was led before them. ⁶⁷ they said,
- C: "If you are the Christ," "tell us."
- **L:** Jesus answered, "If I tell you, you will not believe me, ⁶⁸ and if I asked you, you would not answer. ⁶⁹ But from now on, the Son of Man will be seated at the right hand of the mighty God." ⁷⁰ They all asked,
- C: "Are you then the Son of God?"
- L: He replied, "You are right in saying I am." 71 Then they said,
- C: "Why do we need any more testimony? We have heard it from his own lips."
- **L:** ^{23:1} Then the whole assembly rose and led him off to Pilate. ² And they began to accuse him, saying,
- C: "We have found this man subverting our nation. He opposes payment of taxes to Caesar and claims to be Christ, a king."
- L: ³ So Pilate asked Jesus, "Are you the king of the Jews?" "Yes, it is as you say," Jesus replied. ⁴ Then Pilate announced to the chief priests and the crowd, "I find no basis for a charge against this man." ⁵ But they insisted saying,
- C: "He stirs up the people all over Judea by his teaching. He started in Galilee and has come all the way here."
- **L:** ⁶ On hearing this, Pilate asked if the man was a Galilean. ⁷ When he learned that Jesus was under Herod's jurisdiction, he sent him to Herod, who was also in Jerusalem at that time.
 - ⁸ When Herod saw Jesus, he was greatly pleased, because for a long time he had been wanting to see him. From what he had heard about him, he hoped to see him perform some miracle. ⁹ He plied him with many questions, but Jesus gave him no answer. ¹⁰ The chief priests and the teachers of the law were standing there, vehemently accusing him. ¹¹ Then Herod and his soldiers ridiculed and mocked him. Dressing him in an elegant robe, they sent him back to Pilate. ¹² That day Herod and Pilate became friends—before this they had been enemies.
