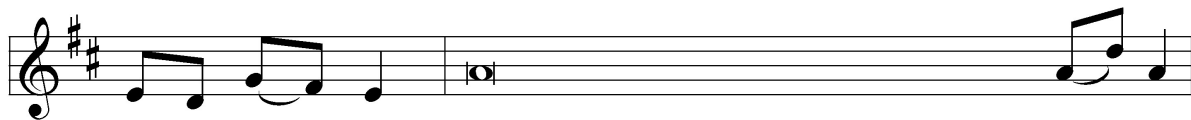

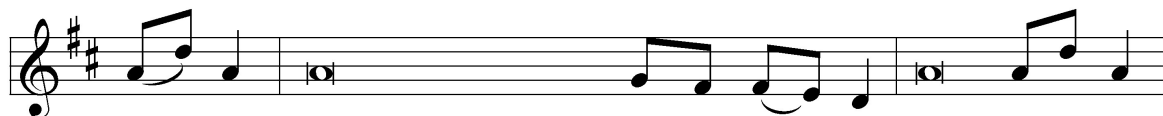

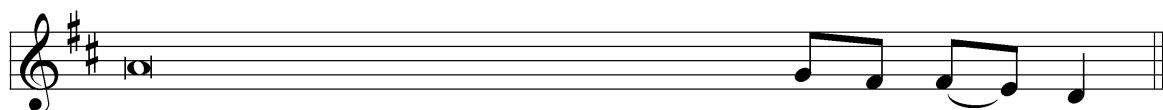

The Nicene Creed: *(together we confess)*
